#### The Cell Phones Timeline

- 1843: A skilled analytical chemist Michael Foraday started to research into whether or not space could conduct electricity. His discoveries have led to the development towards the cell phone.
- 1865: Dr. Mathlon Loomis develops a way to communicate through the atmosphere.
- 1973: Dr. Martin Cooper created the first portable phone and made the first call to a rival working in bell labs.
- 1977: The brick goes public. the phone was very popular.

#### The Current Cell Phone

- Features: size, looks, ergonomic, robustness, screen size, mode, battery type, display included functions, special features, and price.
- Display: size, color or monochrome, reflective or backlight.
- Battery types: Nickel- high capacity battery or Lithium ion – has a lot of power in a light weight package.
- Special Features- text messaging, wireless internet, modem functions, pc synchronization, pda, mp3 player.
- Included Functions- phone directory, speed dial, clock, calculator, games, vibrate mode, custom sounds, alarm, calendar, call forwarding, storage, party calls, redial, car adaptor, recall, and mute.
